CONDENSATE MANAGEMENT

Above grade (e.g., garage)

Sloped to:

- Outside
- Laundry drain

Below grade (e.g., basement)

- Pump to outside
- Sloped to:

 Floor drain
- 1 1001 010111
- Laundry drain

LOCATION CONSIDERATION:

Rooms > 100 sq ft

- Manufacturer required clearances
- Consider future ducting needs

Rooms < 100 sq ft

- Louvered doors
- Venting
- Manufacturer required clearances

POTENTIAL SUPPLIES

- PVC pipe and elbows, primer, glue
- If flex connect, 36 inch flex connect
- Condensate pump

- Venting kit/supplies
- Seismic strapping
- Foam pad

PRO-TIPS

- Size product per code and manufacturer specs
- Condensate pipes sloped per code
- Ensure access for filter cleaning
- No need for Teflon tape with flex connects

- Prime and glue all PVC connections
- Allow clearance for sacrificial rod
- Install noise dampening features as needed
